You will be responsible for working with the Cricket Development Manager within Cornwall to recruit and train Volunteer Co-ordinators for clubs throughout the county. You will provide training and support for Volunteer Co-ordinators and run ECB "Be Involved" workshops throughout the County. You will also be a key driver in promoting NatWest CricketForce and the County OSCAs (Outstanding Services to Cricket Award's).

With participation in cricket rising rapidly, the need to support clubs in the recruitment of volunteers is paramount and this role aims to address that through the recruitment and training of club volunteer coordinators. Particular emphasis will be placed upon encouraging more 16 -25 year olds to volunteer in cricket, in accordance with the ECB's vCricket Programme.

The ideal candidate will have excellent organisational, communication and influencing skills as well the ability to deliver dynamic and engaging presentations. You must be flexible to work unsociable hours (evenings and weekends) and have access to a car and hold a clean driving licence. Experience of working with recreational sports clubs is essential.

Due to the nature of this role, the successful applicant will be asked to apply for an enhanced Criminal Records Bureau disclosure.
