## Yearbooks

It is hoped that the yearbooks will be published, as last year, around the eve of the season – 23 April - bookbinders permitting. ## Cricket Balls

As soon as cricket balls are available, over the next few days, clubs will be notified of distribution arrangements.

## Results Sheets / Umpire Assessment Forms

Results Sheets will be distributed with the balls and books. To start the season the relevant sheets are also attached with this letter to download as required. They are also available from the website homepage at League – Downloads. Please note Division 2 have their own specific result sheet this season. For convenience Premier clubs please use the standard form for both 50/50 Cup and Premier League games.

## Result Reporting – Saturday / Bank Holiday Mondays

A poster is attached detailing arrangements for this season and the new numbers following the death of press correspondent Paul Bawden. A copy will also be included in your result sheets packages. Please display beside club phones and on notice boards and advise relevant members of your club of the changes.

It will be of great help if the following points are specifically noted.

- 1 Submit results **as soon as possible** after games. All seventy odd results at this end have to be compiled, collated, typed with the last sent to the newspaper by 10pm at the latest - so every minute counts.
- 2 Have the relevant scorebook information at hand and keep length of calls to a minimum. Please list runscorers and wicket-takers in order of highest first. Unfortunately we don't want to be rude but we simply do not have time to answer calls requesting on how other teams have got on etc.
- 3 If possible on the evening e-mails, in the correct format, are a preferable time saving alternative but must be received no later than 9.30pm.

## Result Reporting – Play-Cricket

- 1 The ECB deadline for the mandatory upload of full scorecards for Premier League games is now within **48 hours** of the game being played.
- 2 All clubs please ensure **every league match summary score is uploaded** as CCL rules stipulate, even if a cancellation. If not the points are not added to the play cricket league table giving a false table. Full cards are encouraged of course or at least summary individual scores in the highlights section.
- 3 **New for 2010.** Applicable to the Hawkey, Vinter, Clive Rosevear, County 20/20 and Andrew Cups and now also the **Mining Division Evening League**.

All now to be officially reported using the **play cricket system only** instead of result cards.

Home clubs **MUST** input a play-cricket summary result within 24 hours of the match being played. No phone calls required unless the play cricket requirement cannot be fulfilled for some reason at the time. The away Club is then to confirm the result online at their Club's Play cricket website within 48 hours of the match being played in order to verify the result and points input relating to the match. If a full scorecard is not uploaded then a summary of the best performance (20 runs or more and 2 wickets or more) **MUST** be included in the highlights section.

Mining Division Evening League teams please note non CCL teams *Camborne School of Mines* and *Methigion* are not on the play-cricket system at present so you will need to input your away games against them as well as all home games.

Any rearranged or new cup dates please email to Mike Evans or Michael Weeks so the Cornwall cricket website and play-cricket site can be updated.

### **Registrations 2010**

**A timely reminder of procedures.** Some clubs are still not using the correct option when nominating **player transfers**. After completing the player details and nominating please select the player transfer checkbox option rather than the default standard registration. If you select incorrectly the nomination will be rejected and you will have to resubmit. The nomination will only be approved by e-mail once Mike Evans has received the signed and completed Player Transfer Form – available as a download from the website at any time of the year.

**New Rule:** All clubs are reminded to review their existing league registrations annually and remove any players from the Cornwall Cricket League registrations on their Club Play Cricket website **where a player has not played for their club in the previous season**. Any such player will then become available to register at any Club when they wish to play cricket again. The club must then confirm to the league registrations secretary the accuracy of their Club's registrations list. Any deletions, amendments to players' addresses or other details should be made at their Club's Play cricket website by the Club's Play Cricket Administrator. The annual notification should be received by the League registrations secretary before the commencement of the season's fixtures. Any Club failing to make this annual confirmation return will be fined by the League. The annual confirmation return form may be found on the Cornwall Cricket League website.

**Player Transfers** – Before the League accepts any completed transfer form the player **MUST** be nominated by the importing club as a PLAYER TRANSFER on their play-cricket site. The Cornwall Cricket Website has a detailed Registration help and information section with a link from the homepage.

#### **In summary**

Prior to the season all clubs **MUST**:

- 1 **Review** your Club's registrations list online at your Club's Play cricket website ensuring **all** player addresses and **all** dates of birth are correct.
- 2 **Remove any** players that did not play in the 2009 season.
- 3 **New players** must be **nominated** as standard registrations on your play cricket website
- 4 **Transferred players** must be **nominated** as player transfers on your play cricket website **in addition** to completing the official **player transfer forms**.
- 5 Complete the **Annual Review form** ( available at the Cornwall Cricket website). Higher Tier clubs must also name any **Professional** player. This form must be sent to the Cornwall Cricket League Registrations Secretary (Michael Evans) before the first League match of the season. (Rule 15.1.6)
- 6 **Overseas and professional players** - refer to League Rules 14.2, 14.3 & 14.4. An **Overseas Player Authorisation form** must also be completed and sent to Keith Goldsmith (Asst. Sec).It is available as a download from the registration section of the website.
