Divisional Meetings

The Jolly's Drinks Cornwall Cricket League Management Committee will again be holding **divisional group meetings** with representatives of member clubs during September. Dates and venues will be forwarded as soon as confirmed.

Rule Changes

Any club proposals for changes to the League Rules must be sent to the Secretary Michael Evans **by 30th September**. The proposals forms for voting by clubs will be sent out in the second half of October - to be returned by **all clubs by November 15th**. Clubs are advised to plan committee meetings for discussion of the proposals taking into account these dates. A max of 50 words per proposal explaining the reason for change may be included.

The proposal **MUST** include references to the actual rule numbers to be modified/ deleted etc.

Withdrawals / Applications from /to the League

Any withdrawals to be notified to the Secretary at the earliest opportunity as fixture scheduling usually begins in early November. The bottom two teams in the lowest Division, and any team seeking admission to the League, shall make application for election/re-election to the League Secretary not later than **30 September**. Where a team fails, on three occasions in a season, to fulfil a fixture for reasons other than weather or ground conditions, the team shall also be relegated at the end of the season or, if in the lowest division, be required to seek re-election to that division.

League Fees

Fees forms will be distributed by **early October at the latest**. Please note fees must be paid by **31st October**. An automatic fine of £15 per month will apply to late payers.
