



Divisions 2010

You will be aware of the uncertainty about the formation of the divisions for 2010 caused by whether the Premier League is extended to ten teams or remains at eight teams. In accordance with the previously issued statement (*published on page 6 of the 2009 Yearbook and available online*) Grampound Road and Penzance have finished first and second in County Division One. Due to the large number of re-arrangements, and uncertainty over 2nd place in County 1, the LMC is now able and has already begun the process to determine if these clubs meet the ground and facility requirements to be approved for promotion. Until this process has been finalised the make up of all divisions has have to be put on hold of course. Further news will be passed on to all clubs as soon as possible as the LMC are well aware that you are waiting to know the finalised divisions. A reminder any applications for new teams need to be received by the League Secretary **by 30 September**.

Clubs are advised to plan committee meetings for discussion of the proposals taking into account these dates. A max of 50 words per proposal explaining the reason for change may be included. The proposal **MUST** include references to the actual rule numbers to be modified/ deleted etc.
