**JUNIOR CRICKETERS PLAYING IN ADULT MATCHES**

**PARENT or GUARDIAN's CONSENT FORM**

The Latest ECB guidance is to be adopted apart from that referring to Under 11 age players, whereby new **CCL ruling 14.1.14 shall apply. ie - a player must be a minimum of 12 years of age on the actual match day to participate in CCL matches."**

Any player in the Under 13 age-group must have explicit written consent from a parent or guardian before participating in adult matches. (Age-groups are based on the age of the player at midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> August in the year preceding the current season).

To comply with this guidance the League requests a parental letter of consent and where a young talented player is playing in the higher divisions and under regular County coaching we receive a statement from the coach that the player is technically sound to play with adults at a higher level.
