Player registration on play-cricknet - introduction

What is it?

- an on-line registration system
- available free of charge to all leagues that have an active play-cricknet site.
- clubs submit details of their players to the league for approval
- only approved players can be used in play-cricknet

Player registration on play-cricknet - introduction

- introduction of online player registration leads clubs to tidy up player database.
- results in greater accuracy of data.

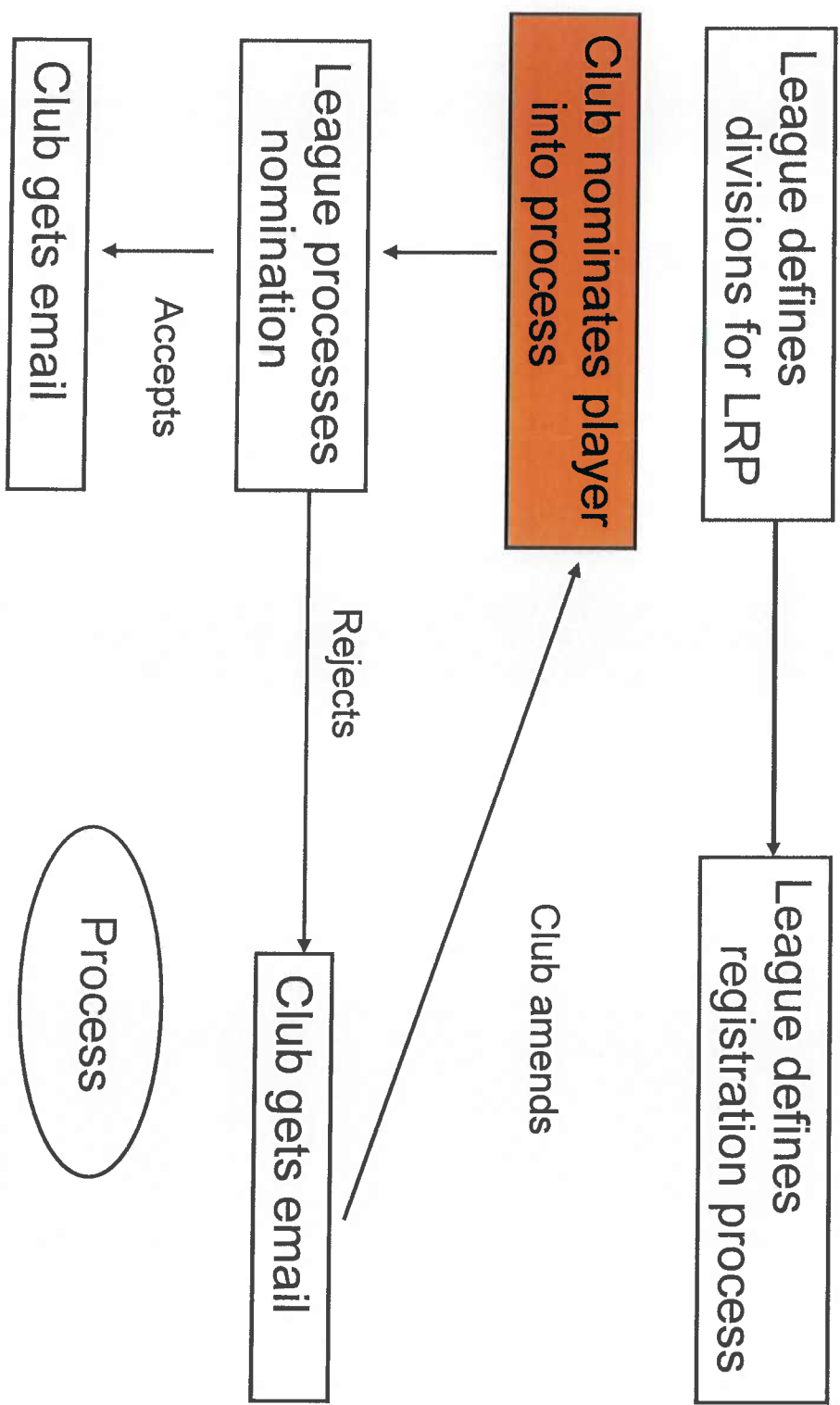
Player registration on play-cricknet - introduction

What has changed?

- a 'process' for the league side of the system
- checks can made against the databases of other leagues.
- Introduction of other functionality in future releases
- email to notify the administrator what has happened to registration, and reason for rejection.

Process

Club registration of players

- If LRP is active for a division, then only registered players can be used.
- player must be in the club's database to be a registered player
- each player should have a single entry in their club's database
- best done before starting the process
