

JOLLY'S DRINKS CORNWALL CRICKET LEAGUE

2011 October Proposals Voting Results

Clubs were allocated either 1 vote (one team) or 2 votes (2 or more teams) for proposals 11-18. For all other proposals clubs were allocated one vote per team playing in each of the relevant tiers.

17 of the 20 proposals received 40% or more of votes actually cast (15 got 50% or more, 11 got 60% or more).

No Numbers were 5 (12.30 Premier starts), 19 (New ball each inns Divs 2, 3 & 5) and 20 (3 up & down standard tier).

1	55%	Rule 14.1.13		Amend to read: Apart from the Registered Professional and Seasonal Overseas player see 14.2 and 14.3, no player shall receive payment from the club, or any other interested party, e.g. Business, sponsor etc for playing or providing any services. Clubs shall be limited to one Registered Professional and one 'Seasonal' overseas player who shall be recorded on the 'Annual Player Registration Confirmation form' and recorded as either a Category 2 or Category 3 player on the club's Play Cricket Site.
2	64	Rule 14.3.1.1		Amend to read: No other playing member in the club, apart from the registered professional and 'Seasonal' overseas player, shall receive financial support or services or goods of any kind from the club or any other party associated with the club e.g. sponsors, businesses etc for playing for the club. The club may employ a playing member to undertake contractual commercial services for the club such as maintenance of premises and playing facilities. This exception does not apply to the Registered Professional and 'Seasonal' overseas player.

5	30	Rule 18.2.1	<p>Amend to read: All matches to start at 12.30pm.</p> <p><i>Proposer note: Standardises start time throughout the season</i></p>
6	100	Rule 18.15.5	<p>Create new rule: Every player shall be qualified and registered as per League rules 14 & 15; any player having played in the Premier League Cup Competition shall be “cup tied” and not be eligible to play for any other club in that competition in the current season.</p> <p><i>Proposer note: Eliminates loophole of a player being able to play for two clubs in the competition in the same season</i></p>

7	50			<p>Create New Rule Scorers 19.13.1 The provision of a competent non-playing scorer is mandatory in all County Division 1 fixtures. 19.13.2 Failure of a club to provide a competent non-playing scorer, as required by the rule above, will result in a penalty of 2 points for each such failure as reported by the panel umpires.</p> <p><i>Proposer note: As already in place for the Premier League.</i></p>

8	60			<p>Amend to read: All matches played up to and including 14 August to start at 2.00pm and thereafter, at 1.30pm. If passed Amend 21.2 to read - refer to 20.2 (only) and Delete 21.2.1 (duplication) <i>Proposer note: Reverting to 2010 timings.</i></p>
9	45			<p>Amend to read: 20.7.1 A new quartered leather Oxbridge St James ball shall be provided by the home club and lodged with the umpires before the commencement of matches in Divisions 3 & 4. 20.7.2 For Division 2 matches, each side shall provide one new quartered leather ball (Oxbridge Blenheim, rule 17.7.3) which shall be lodged with the umpires before the commencement of the match. The side fielding second shall have the option to use the second new ball at the commencement of the innings only; if this option is not exercised, the original ball, or that substituted for it during play, must be used throughout the 2nd innings. 20.7.3 Two good used match balls must be available at all such matches. <i>Proposer note: New ball to be available for <u>each</u> innings in Division 2</i></p>

10	72			<p>Amend to read:except in division 7 which shall remain at 2.00pm throughout the season. <i>Proposer note : There are 16 overs <u>less</u> to be bowled in these 40 over per side matches so the earlier start is unnecessary as games finish earlier in any case.</i></p>

11	66		<p>Rule 14.1.10</p> <p>Rewrite to read Shall play no part in any other Saturday League Competition, except the Tamar League, without obtaining approval from the LMC. <i>Proposer note : Allows players within a club to interchange between the Cornwall and Tamar Saturday Leagues only</i></p>
12	47		<p>Rule 17.8.4.1</p> <p>Create New Rule <i>Clubs shall be fined £5 for each late result entry on Club's Play cricket website</i></p>
13	67		<p>Rule 20.6.2</p> <p>Insert as Rule 20.6.2 If there is an interruption in play during the first innings which causes the number of overs to be reduced then the maximum number of overs available to each bowler must be recalculated as per Rule 20.6.1. If a bowler has exceeded the limit set in Rule 20.6.1 then he will not be permitted to bowl again unless it is to complete an unfinished over. In such a case the restrictions on bowlers in the second innings may be adjusted to match those in the first innings, which in some cases may mean a bowler legitimately exceeds the maximum number of overs as stated in Rule 20.6.1. <i>Proposer note : The team batting first are always disadvantaged if the first innings is subsequently reduced part way through. Without this amendment they are further disadvantaged by possibly not being able to use their best bowler(s) as much as the other team. In all games that I have played this happens anyway ignoring the letter of the rule. This therefore formalises it.</i> <i>LMC note: To be consistent throughout the League, this would also mean that we would have to change 18.6.1.1, 18.18.1.1, 19.6.2, 20.6.2</i></p>
14	72		<p>Rule 20.6.3</p> <p>Move from Rule 20.6.2 and adjust to read: The umpires will, in a reduced over match and prior to start (or restart) of the innings, advise captains and scorers of maximum number of overs available per bowler. <i>Proposer note : This would be more appropriate if it came after the new rule 20.6.2 with the obvious requirement added in brackets.</i> <i>LMC note: also requires amended rules 18.6.1.2, 18.18.1.2, 19.6., 20.6.3 - to be consistent throughout the League.</i></p>
15	75		<p>Rule 25</p> <p>Amend rules 25.1, 25.2, 25.3 and 25.5 That the LMC will standardise the playing rules of the Vinter, Hawkey and Edwards Cup Competitions to the current National T20 competition format. <i>Proposer note : All three competitions to play under the same set of rules.</i></p>
16	88		<p>Rule 25.1.10</p> <p>Amend to read: For all matches before the Semi-Finals and Final, reasonably sound cricket balls (current League match balls) shall be provided by the home club. For each Semi-Final and Final, the Competition will provide a new ball and each side shall also provide a reasonable spare ball (current League match balls) to be lodged with the umpires before the start of the match. <i>Proposer note : Formally states the requirement for clubs to provide spare balls for semi-finals and final.</i></p>
17	68		<p>Rule 25.1.10</p> <p>Amend second sentence to read: The competition will provide a new ball for each innings in each semi-final and the final. <i>Proposer note : A new ball per innings rather than per match.</i> <i>LMC note: If proposals 16 & 17 are both passed the amended rule for the Hawkey, Vinter & Edwards Cup competitions will incorporate both amendments.</i></p>
18	53		<p>Rule 25.1.10</p> <p>Amend second sentence to read: The competition will provide a new ball for each semi-final and for each innings in the final. <i>Proposer note : A new ball per innings in the final only rather than per match.</i> <i>LMC note: If proposals 16 & 18 are both passed the amended rule for the Hawkey, Vinter & Edwards Cup competitions will incorporate both amendments.</i></p>

19	31	Rule 20.7	Delete contents and replace as follows: Refer to 18.7 <i>Proposer note: With the cost of match balls having been reduced (£7 for St James Ball in 2011) and the standard of ground rising the logical step would be to continue to make the contest as even as possible by having a new ball available for the start of both innings. A bigger order of cricket balls may enable the price per ball to be reduced even further.</i> <i>LMC note: New ball to be available for each innings in <u>Divisions 2, 3 & 4</u> rather than proposal 9 which is for division 2 only.</i>	
The following (20) to be voted on by Standard Tier League Clubs only i.e. Clubs playing in Divs 5 and below in 2012 (1 vote per team)

20	28	Rule 11.1.10	Create new rule and renumber existing rules 11.1.10 -11.1.12 Not withstanding adjustments required as detailed in Rule 11.1.9, promotion and relegation within the Standard Tier shall be three up and three down. <i>Proposer note : It is felt that for reasons other than cricket ability some teams are kept in incorrect divisions for their standard (withdrawal of other clubs is an obvious reason) and the divisions that are affect the most are those from the Standard Tier. This rule proposal would allow a greater flow of teams in the lower divisions. Promotion between Intermediate and Standard tiers remains 2 up and 2 down (ie Div 4 to Div 5).</i>
