

CORNWALL CRICKET BOARD COACHES ASSOCIATION 2010 WINTER COACHING PROGRAMME

Cornwall Cricket Board in partnership with the Cornwall Association of Cricket Coaches has their winter coach education programme planned for 2010.

There will be one UKCC1 coaching course, (for Assistant coaches) and two UKCC2 coaching courses (Lead Coach Qualification). Candidates can if they feel confident and have a cricket background progress straight into UKCC2. Completing UKCC1 is not a prerequisite of doing UKCC2. UKCC2 can be the starting point for coaching qualifications.

Any coach completing the qualification must join the ECB CA (£25.00) once certification. Insurance and safeguarding yourself during any future coaching are amongst some of the many benefits. Please look at the link below.

UKCC1 Cricket Coaching Qualification

The UKCC1 coaching course will qualify the individual to an assistant coach qualification. This will enable the assistant coach to support a lead coach in the club environment and not lead coaching sessions.

The UKCC1 course will last for 12 hours with a coaching assessment at the end of the tuition. This assessment will take the shape of a 15 minute coaching delivery of an activity that has been delivered over the tuition. There will be a multiple choice question paper to complete during the main assessment day.

This course is aimed at parents or young cricketers who have little cricket or presenting experience.

UKCC2 Cricket Coaching Qualification

The UKCC2 coaching qualification will qualify the coach to lead coaching sessions in their club environment. This course is recommended for those clubs and individuals who are seeking to manage and coach teams within in their clubs. The course is designed for the more confident individual and experienced cricketer.

It is recommended that candidates who have an experience of cricket and presenting progress straight onto UKCC2.

The UKCC2 coaching course is 24 hours in duration split in to eight three hour modules. After modules 1 to 8 the coach will have to complete a minimum of 6 hours supported practice sessions. These sessions can be delivered in the club and Area coaching environment. It is the responsibility of the individual coach to work with the Cornwall Association of cricket coaches to organise their supported practice sessions with the assistance of a UKCC2 or higher qualified coach.

The assessment once the supported practice sessions have been completed encompasses an open book multiple choice question paper, a 15 minute delivery of a coaching session and five shadow demonstrations.

Course Prerequisites

First Aid and Safeguarding and Child Protection Courses .

These qualifications are pre-requisites for attending the UKCC coaching courses. Candidates either need to show evidence of attending in the form of a certificate or a booking form on application.

First Aid courses have been arranged through Lusty Glaze Training Centre.

Candidates can contact Lusty Glaze on 01637 879642 to enquire and book a place. The First Aid courses will cost £25.00 for each candidate.

Safeguarding and Child Protection Courses will be organised through the Cornwall Sports Partnership. To book a place the candidate will need to contact the Cornwall Sports Partnership on 01872 323344. This course will cost £25.00 per candidate. Please note that these courses only last for three years and will need to be updated after three years.

ECB Coaches Association – Coaches Insurance and Benefits

After completing the coaching course coaches will need to join the ECBCA (Coaches Association) to be fully insured when they are coaching in the club environment. Coaches can join the ECBCA by going onto their website <http://ecbca.playcricket.com/home/home.asp> and download the application form this will also be a valuable place to see the benefits of joining the ECBCA. The required forms can also be downloaded from the Cornwall Cricket Board Website www.cornwallcricket.org.uk

The ECB CA membership will cost £25.00 per year. For this the coach will receive insurance, coaching resources, discounted coaching clothing and invitations to coaching conferences.
