Cornwall Welfare Officer Training – Time to Listen Courses



The 'Time to Listen' course aims to outline roles and responsibilities for Club Welfare Officers, give an overview of legislation, roles of external agencies, increase awareness of harmful behaviour to children and young people and to outline principles of working with children and vulnerable adults.

All affiliated cricket clubs to the Cornwall Cricket League have to have an appointed and fully trained Child Welfare Officer. Any club that does not currently have a trained child welfare officer needs to book and place on one of the two courses.

Please complete the form to reserve a place on one of the courses below. This will be on a first come first served basis, both courses need to be filled as there are 50 untrained CWO and only 50 places. A club will only be able to train one CWO on these courses to allow all other clubs to apply.
