

Cornwall School's Cricket Association Presentation Evening on Saturday 1st October 2011

The young Somerset leg spin bowler Max Waller was the guest of honour at the Cornwall Schools' Cricket Association's Annual Presentation Evening held at Perranporth. He had just returned from India having played for Somerset in the Champions League T20 tournament. Two long serving officials of the Association, John Platts and Terry Barker, received special presentations to mark their respective retirements. John has completed fifty years as a player and manager and in recent years has looked after the Under Seventeen side. Terry began managing sides in 1973 and has also been the Association's Treasurer for the last seventeen years. In a tribute from former CSCA Chairman Les Driver he said "They have both been stalwarts of CSCA and hundreds of young people are better as cricketers, sportsmen and sportswomen, and as people, through knowing them and through having enjoyed their guidance and advice. It is almost impossible to name a Cornwall cricketer who has not benefitted from their vast experience. Their alleged "retirement" will leave a huge hole in CSCA, their management skills, discipline and humour are legendary, it will take a lot to replace them".

James Rowe was the recipient of the Ted Collins Memorial Cup for the outstanding young cricketer. Along with Ben Kitt he made a stunning debut for Cornwall's Minor Counties team in their history making win over Cheshire. Despite losing players to both Cornwall and first class counties the Under 17's went on to reach the ECB National semi-final for the second successive year before narrowly losing to Hertfordshire.
